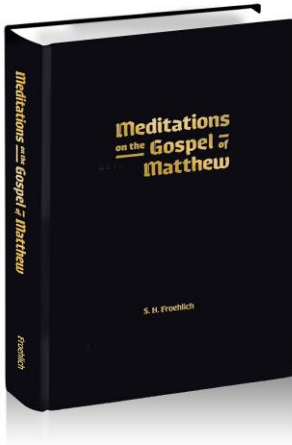

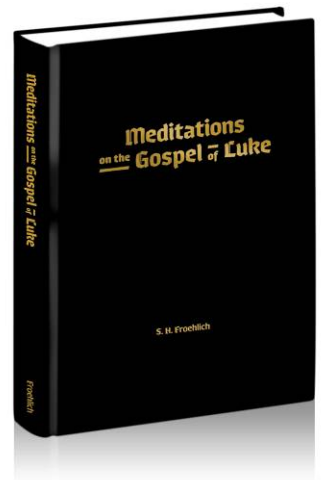

## *A Selection from History*

The following words were spoken by Bro. Theo Beer from Milford, IN, on March 6, 1960, after reading St. Matthew 6:

It is a small thing for God to bless us in our labors and it is also within His power to withhold from us our blessings....Almost every spring, since we are tillers of the soil, when we begin to go out again to our labors and to prepare the fields, at least I've been afflicted with this thought: it may be this year the Lord will not bless our efforts. And then we think, we thought the same thing last year. And in spite of the rainy weather or in spite of the drought, to our great surprise there was an abundant harvest. I often feel ashamed of myself, beloved ones, that we are not trusting enough; we are not believing what God has promised unto us. When we think back over the years that we have lived, we have lived in a wonderful land if we dare say it - a land that has brought forth bountifully. If we would compare our blessings that the Lord has given us in our daily labors against the reverses they are not to be compared. The Lord has bountifully blessed us - over and over again has filled our garner to overflowing....In one of our Sunday School programs at one time a young boy got up and mentioned a little poem that stuck with me. "Yesterday God helped me; today I'll praise His name; for I know that tomorrow, He'll help me just the same." I went home and I thought about that. Yesterday God helped us. And surely today we can praise His name. And how wonderful it is if we have confidence and believe that tomorrow He will help us too if we trust Him.
