WHAT IS HCF?

The Heritage Center Foundation was incorporated in 2006 as a non-profit organization. The purpose statement of the Heritage Center is: to preserve and promote Christian history from the perspective of the believers who have experienced a spiritual rebirth through a true repentance, conversion and baptism, and who chose to practice a literal interpretation of the Holy Scriptures, separated from the world, as revived and put in remembrance by Samuel H. Froehlich in Switzerland in the 1830s. Said purpose is furthered by maintaining a reference library of historic Christian materials, by creating publications of historic Christian materials, and by any other actions necessary or related thereto, all for the benefit of present and future generations.

HERITAGE CENTER LIBRARY

The *Heritage Center Library* contains an array of materials and artifacts. Some historical treasures that can be found in the library include: a nearly complete archive of Silver Linings, baptismals from early local churches, a rocking chair built by Benedict Weyeneth, memorabilia from believers who suffered persecution behind the Iron Curtain and more. The library is located in the FBFM building at 120 N. Main Street, P. O. Box 135, Eureka, IL 61530.

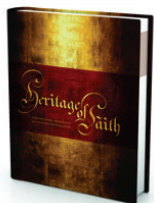
A PILGRIM'S VOYAGE

A republished booklet now released by the Heritage Center Foundation. *For the Truth's Sake* is a chronicle of transcripts from the court records of Schweinfurt, Bavaria from 1850 to 1854, concerning the formation of a new Evangelical Baptist congregation by Andrew Braun and followers. Within the transcripts, the reader will find an inspiring confession of faith and will read an account of what happened when church authorities tried to force a young believing couple to have their infant baptized in the state church. Braun and his flock were persecuted to the point that they left their homeland of Germany and came to America where freedom of religion was protected.

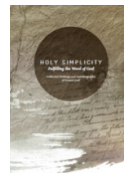

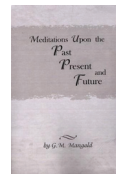
HOLY SIMPLICITY - ERNEST GRAF AUTOBIOGRAPHY

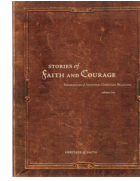

In his addresses, S. H. Froehlich chose (for the most part) continuous Bible texts, and thus he spoke about complete portions of the Bible, verse by verse. After the sermon, he wrote short notations in his diary. The meditations are central to understanding the blessed plan of salvation and how true believers are to honor their Savior with a living and saving faith in Him. These new black hardback books are more accurate English translations of those notations, are more understandable, and include cited Scripture excerpts for reference.



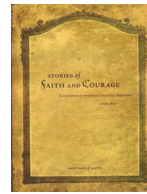

**TO THE KING'S ADMINISTRATION
OF JUSTICE: A STATEMENT OF
FAITH IN 1878

A statement of Faith, written September 18, 1878, was sent to the King's Administration of Justice in Wurtemberg, Germany. Johann Schlipf, Johann Aupperle, and Christian Schlipf were elder brothers in the church originally established with the help of Brother Samuel Froehlich. The following declaration, while confirming respect and honor

for the government ordained by God, clearly confirms that the believers would not disobey God's Word as demanded by the authorities of that time. 13 pages, available at no charge.
